

## FSU wins as Carey ups mark to 8-0

**JACKSONVILLE** — Lefthander Brooks Carey stretched his record to 8-0 here Sunday afternoon as Florida State University knocked off Jacksonville University, 11-5.

Carey managed to get the win despite falling behind 2-0 in the first inning and giving up 13 hits. Carey, however, gave up only one extra base

hit, a double in the second inning to Jacksonville's Frank Chamberlain.

Florida State scored four runs in the top of the third to take a 4-2 lead, and then scored three in the fourth and three more in the eighth to clinch the victory. The Seminoles scored their 11th run in the ninth.

FSU's Bob Benda started the big

fourth inning when he led off with a single. Craig Patterson then walked, and David Mobley singled, scoring Benda from second. Jacksonville's lead was cut to 2-1.

With runners on first and third, Blane McDonald, the next FSU batter, hit a long sacrifice fly that scored Patterson from third. Don Milner then singled and reached second on

an error by the Jacksonville first baseman. Milner's hit drove in Mobley, and FSU led, 3-2. The Seminoles' Greg Jones doubled to score Milner to make it 4-2. There was no further scoring in the inning.

FSU's three-run fourth inning was sparked by Blane McDonald's two-run single.

FSU hosts Knoxville of the Southern AA League at Seminole Field this afternoon at 3 p.m. The Seminoles are expected to play a lot of their reserves in the exhibition game. Admission is free.
