## Vegas makes it four in a row against FSU

LAS VEGAS, Nev. — Like most vistors to this gambling town, Florida State's baseball team wound up the loser, including three fly balls in the sun and the shirt off its back for the fourth straight time Sunday as Nevada-Las Vegas complete the four-

game sweep with a 13-6 victory.

The Seminoles were scheduled to limp back into Tallhassee Monday in time for the opening of the series with rival University of Florida at Seminole Field Wednesday night.

<sup>4</sup> The four-game series here saw the No. 3 ranked Seminoles outscored 41 to 17 and outhit 59 to 34.

Sunday's game was typical, as unranked Vegas pounded out 14 hits to hike its record to 33-15 and send the Seminoles home with a 34-11 record.

Vegas broke a 5-5 tie in the bottom of the fifth on a triple and wild pitch and broke it wide open with five runs in the sixth, highlighted by Vance Mc-Henry's two-run homer.

The defeat was pegged on Don De-Loach, now 2-1, who worked three and two-thirds innings in relief of starter Rick Holloway, who lasted one and a third innings. DeLoach was touched for four runs, including the tie-breaker on the wild pitch in the fifth.

The Seminoles had started fast in this one, scoring five of their six runs off six of their 10 hits in the first two innings.

They put together a run-scoring triple by Bob Benda and run-scoring doubles by Craig Patterson and Don Milner for three runs and a 5-1 lead in the top of the second.

But the pitching and nelding couldn't hold Vegas, which started the series with a 16-4 victory over FSU. The Seminoles made it close only once, losing 3-1 in the second game before falling 9-6 on Saturday.
