## Seminoles win tenth straight

Stealing eight bases, Florida State made it 10 wins in a row and 12 in the last 13 games, beating Mercer University of Atlanta 4-2 Monday at Seminole Field.

Mike Fuentes, who Sunday drove in nine runs on two homers, used his speed to help build the first two FSU runs.

After Mercer took a 1-0 lead in the second inning on Mark Clark's home run, Fuentes in the bottom of the inning walked, stole second and went to third when the throw sailed into centerfield. He scored on Ronnie Traylor's infield out.

Then in the fourth, Fuentes singled, and again stole second. David Mobley's single sent Fuentes to third, and he scored on a wild pitch.

Traylor grounded out, sending Mobley to third, and after Ron Bart-

lett fanned, Jeff Ledbetter walked, putting runners on first and third.

Ledbetter, on first, and Mobley on third pulled a double-steal to make the score 3-1.

The Seminoles scored their final run in the seventh when Craig Patterson's sacrifice fly sent Bruce Huff in from third base.

Mercer added a single run in the eighth off Joe Nichols, pitching in relief of starter Rick Hatcher.

The Seminoles (18-4) take to the road today and tomorrow for a pair against South Florida in Tampa.
