## FSU sweeps Wright State

Craig Patterson crashed a schoolrecord two grand slam home runs and powered Florida State to a 13-6 victory over Wright State and a sweep of a Saturday afternoon college baseball doubleheader at Seminole Field.

Patterson, who drove home 11 runs in the doubleheader, had a three-run homer in the first game as the Seminoles won 12-0 behind the four-hit, shutout pitching of Jim Riley.

The sweep ran the Seminoles' victory streak to 16 and pushed their record to 24-4 after winning 19 of their last 20 games.

The team takes the day off today and resumes action Monday with a single game at 3:30 p.m. against Stetson at Seminole Field.

Patterson, who now has five homers for the season and four in the last three games, stroked his first basesloaded homer in the Seminoles' sixrun third inning that wiped out a 3-0 Wright State lead. His second basesjammed homer came in the fifth as the Seminoles pushed their lead to 12-3. Joe Nichols, in relief of starter Jeff Ledbetter, picked up the pitching victory, his second without a defeat.

But, the pitching story of the day was the one carved out by Riley who

scatterd the Raiders' four hits and didn't allow a base runner to second base until the last inning.

He also reaped the benefits of the Seminoles' booming bats, which lashed out 26 hits (13 in each game) and produced 25 runs in just 12 turns at bat.

Patterson belted his first-game, three-run homer in a nine-run sixth inning outbreak in which Mike

Fuentes belted his second round-tripper of the game and ninth of the year. He had hit a solo homer in the fourth inning in a back-to-back performance with catcher Jack Emerick.

Fuentes now has 35 runs batted in for the season.
