Seminoles rally to win 2nd game at Ga. Southern

STATESBORO, Ga. — Trailing 4-0 after two innings, Florida State rallied to edge Georgia Southern 5-4 in the second game of a doubleheader here Sunday afternoon.

Georgia Southern won the first game, 7-4.

Georgia Southern opened the second game with four straight singles off Seminoles' starter Rick Hatcher.

Terry Metts singled, driving home Chip Gray to make the score 1-0, and Mark Strucher drove home Sergio Crego to make it 2-0.

In the second, Bob Laurie doubled for Georgia Southern, and Jorge Lazcano reached on an error. Scott Fletcher singled Laurie home, and Georgia Southern's lead climbed to 3-0.

Lazcano scored on a double play, and Georgia Southern went ahead 4-0.

FSU WOKE UP in the third, with David Mobley scoring on a single by Craig Patterson to make it 4-1.

Mobley's sacrifice fly in the fourth scored Jack Emer-

ick, and the Eagles' lead was cut to 4-2.

In the fifth, Craig Patterson reached on an error, and Mike Fuentes singled him home to make it 4-3. Jeff Ledbetter reached first on a single, and Emerick hit into a fielder's choice that allowed Fuentes to score from third. Fuentes' run tied the game at 4-4.

The Seminoles went ahead in the sixth. Bruce Huff led with a single and stole second. He moved to third when Don DeLoach grounded out. Huff scored when Eddie Rod-

riguez threw a wild pitch.

TRAILING 5-4, Georgia Southern threatned to regain the lead in the bottom of the seventh.

Mark Strucher led with a double, and went to third when the throw from the outfield got away from DeLoach at shortstop. Reliever Tim Smith then came into the game for FSU, replacing Hatcher.

Smith got Carmelo Aguayo to ground out to short for the first out. Metts hit a grounder to Milner at first base, and Milner threw Strucher out at the plate. Smith then struckout Bob Laurie to end the game. It was Smith's fourth save of the year.

Georgia Southern also jumped out to a quick lead in

tthe first game.

Crego and Gray singled, putting men on first and third. Strutcher then homered off FSU starter Ken Riley to make it 3-0

FSU came back in the third inning to tie the game. DeLoach singled and Patterson tripled, scoring De-Loach to make it 3-1. Fuentes walked, and Jeff Ledbetter singled home Patterson, cutting Georgia Southern's lead to 3-2. Ron Traylor then hit a sacrifice fly to score Fuentes and tie the game at 3-3.

The Seminoles went ahead in the fourth, when Fuentes singled to score Huff, giving FSU a 4-3 lead.

Georgia Southern scored four runs to go ahead 7-4 in the bottom of the inning. The Eagles scored on a tworun double by Bob Laurie, and scored two more runs on singles.

FSU threatned in the sixth and sev-

enth, but couldn't score.

FSU is now 33-9, while Georgia Southern is 28-10. FSU plays at Jacksonville Wednesday.
