Holloway, Seminoles stop Tech

ATLANTA — Rick Holloway, making his first appearance since an April 1 loss to St. Leo, pitched a complete game victory as Florida State beat Georgia Tech 5-2 Saturday.

Holloway, a senior righthander, scattered 11 hits to win his fifth of the

year against two losses.

Georgia Tech (12-13) scored both its runs in the first on Tommy Thompson's two-run homer. The blow, which erased a 1-0 FSU lead, was Thompson's 14th homer of the season.

Second baseman Craig Patterson, as has been his custom lately, supplied much of the FSU offense, cracking his ninth homer of the year and a double among his three hits.

The Seminoles (38-11) stole nine bases, with rightfielder Bruce Huff swiping four and centerfielder Mike

Fuentes taking three.

Two errors helped FSU score first off Tech starter Jim Thorsten, who also pitched a complete game. With two out in the first inning, Patterson reached base on an error by third baseman Doug Ibele. After stealing second, Patterson scored when Thompson, playing first, booted Jeff Ledbetter's grounder.

Thompson made up for the goof with his homer in the bottom of the inning. But FSU regained the lead for good in the third when Huff singled, stole second and scored on Patter-

son's double.

The game became a pitcher's duel until the eighth, when Patterson led off with his home run.

The teams play again today at 12:30. Jim Riley (7-2) will pitch for the Seminoles.
