Seminoles pound out 11-4 victory

ATLANTA — Scoring all its runs in the fourth and fifth innings, Florida State pounded Georgia Tech 11-4. Sunday to sweep the two-game series.

Don DeLoach, Ronnie Traylor and Craig Ramsey all homered for the Seminoles, helping pitcher Jim Riley to his eighth win against two losses.

Riley, the senior righthander pitching in his home town, went the first six innings, allowing three runs on six hits. He walked three and fanned six.

Rick Hatcher, Ken Fischer and Ken Smith each worked an inning of relief as the Seminoles extended their record to 39-11.

FSU exploded for eight runs in the fourth, after the Yellow Jackets (12-14) had gone ahead 1-0 in the third inning. DeLoach, the sophomore shortstop from Leon High, led off

with his seventh homer of the season to tie the game 1-1. Craig Patterson doubled, and after Jeff Ledbetter flied out, scored on Mike Fuentes' double.

Don Milner walked and David Mobley singled Fuentes in to give the Noles a 3-1 lead. Then Traylor hit his fourth homer, a three-run shot that made the score 6-1 and drove Tech starter Don Gee from the game.

Ramsey greeted reliefer Alan Broadwater with a double, moving to third on Bruce Huff's infield out, and scoring on a wild pitch. DeLoach, batting for the second time in the inning, was hit by a pitch, and then Patterson hit his second double of the frame, sending DeLoach home with the eighth FSU run.

In the fifth, Ramsey topped the scoring with a three-run homer, his third circuit blast of the year.

FSU is off until Wednesday when it meets Florida A&M at 7:30 at Seminole Field.
