Weaver lifts FSU to 4th win

Jim Weaver's bases-loaded triple in the sixth inning broke a 3-3 deadlock and led Florida State to a 10-3 victory over Lenoir Rhyne Monday at

chilly Seminole Field.

Mike Yastrzemski added his third home run of the year and a run-scoring double as the Seminoles won their fourth straight and pushed their record to 4-2.

Junior lefthander Ed Schneider, a transfer from Indian River Junior College, recorded his first pitching

victory for the Seminoles.

Schneider pitched 6% innings, allowing three runs and three hits. He walked six and struck out eight. John Gagnon and Ken Fischer mopped up for FSU.

Florida State Coach Mike Martin said Schneider threw hard and apparently has recovered from a sore shoulder that caused him to miss all of fall practice.

"I was very impressed with the way he pitched," Martin said. "We had him at 88 to 90 (miles per hour) most of the day. It was very encour-

The Seminoles returned to action after rain and cold weather postponed a three-game weekend series with Georgia Southern. Martin said the rustiness of not playing since last

Wednesday was evident.

"I was glad to be finally playing baseball," Martin said. "That layoff didn't help us. Missing five days isn't good for a young team. It definitely had an effect in the first five innings because we weren't sharp and we weren't concentrating."

Playing in 40-degree temperatures, the visitors from North Carolina capitalized on two walks, three stolen bases and three passed balls by FSU catcher Jack Emerick to take a 2-0 lead in the top of the first inning.

The Seminoles came back in the bottom of the first to tie the game. Jeff Ledbetter's high pop was dropped by Bears' leftfielder Chuck MacLaughlin allowing Weaver to score the first run. Yastrzemski then doubled home Ledbetter for the sec-

Lenoir Rhyne took the lead for the final time in the top of the third when Del Ammons slugged a home run off Schneider for a 3-2 Bears' advantage.

Yaz's solo homer tied the game in the bottom of the frame, and it stayed that way until the sixth. Three walks by losing pitcher Danny Browner loaded the bases, and Weaver delivered his triple. Ledbetter singled for to make the score 7-3.

FSU completed the scoring in the seventh on a runscoring single by Don DeLoach and Birdie Tebbetts' tworun double.

The Seminoles travel to Jacksonville to play the Dolphins in a single game this afternoon at 3 and a doubleheader Wednesday at 1 p.m.

They return home for games Saturday and Sunday against the Florida Gators.
