# Sentiment nearly sinks Seminoles

Florida State baseball Coach Mike Martin did his good deed for the season and almost paid the price of a very costly favor.

Martin, always a nice guy, put Wingate (N.C.) College on his schedule for sentimental reasons. An NAIA member playing a full slate of games against four-year schools for the first time, Wingate was Martin's alma mater when it was a junior college.

So much for sentiment. FSU had to score three in the bottom of the seventh to escape with a 5-4 victory in the second game of a double-header Tuesday at Seminole Field.

The Seminoles' Don DeLoach helped avert the upset with a bases-loaded single with two out that drove in two runs.

In the first game, Ken Fischer's one-hit pitching over five innings paced the Seminoles to an easier 6-0 decision in the first game.

Before Martin starred at Florida State, he played for Wingate Junior College in 1963 and 1964.

His coach then was Ron Christopher, who retired in 1972 and then returned this season when Wingate became accredited as a four-year institution. Christopher's young squad was primed to spring a giant upset.

The Bulldogs built a 4-0 lead after five innings against FSU and pitcher Ken Smith. Rick Black, a soft-throwing righthander, was keeping the Seminoles off-balance and had held them to two hits.

But he tired in the sixth and was taken out after walking Roy Alvarez and Rick Figueredo. An infield out moved the runners to second and third — Ken Huff was running for Figueredo — and DeLoach singled off Bo Harrill between shortstop and third base to score two runs.

When Jim Weaver walked, it appeared FSU was about to overtake the Bulldogs, but new pitcher Doug Smith got Jeff Ledbetter to ground into an inning-ending double play.

The Seminoles had to wait until their final chance.

Leading off the seventh, Mike Fuentes walked. Mike Yastrzemski pinch-hit a single and Mike Cullen grounded to first, advancing the runners to second and third. Roy Alvarez walked to fill the bases with one out.

Stu Carmichael came in to face Dick Wiggins, pinch-hitting for Ed Howser. Two weeks ago, Wiggins pinch-hit a grand slam to beat Troy State, but there were no story-book endings this time. Wiggins fanned.

Now two were out. Lionel Martinez worked the count to 3-2, and walked, forcing in the Seminoles' third run.

Then it was DeLoach again. The junior shortstop dug into a 1-2 hole before hitting a soft line drive into short left field in front of a charging Jim Morris.

"My mind said to dive, but I just couldn't," Morris said. "I could have had it."

The hit scored Yaz and Alvarez, and the Seminoles pushed their record to 9-3.

"I was just trying to protect the plate," DeLoach said. "I got just enough of it to get it over third base and in front of the leftfielder."

DeLoach, a .325 hitter each of the last two seasons, came into the double-header batting .265. His 2-for-4 in the second game after 0-for-2 in the first raised his average to .282.

"I started this way last year too,"

he said. "So I'm not varying too much. I hope I catch fire like last year."

The Seminoles got just five hits while the Bulldogs were peppering Smith with 10. The senior righthander nevertheless went the distance to earn his second victory without a defeat.

"We were very, very fortunate," Martin said. "When you get outlited 10-5 and beat somebody, you've got to be thankful."

Martin said he scheduled Wingate when he was an assistant coach — a big-hearted one — before taking over for Dick Howser.

"We had nothing to gain and everything to lose," Martin said. "But a game like this could go a long way to helping the kids."

It also helped Wingate, 1-2, which had beaten Olivet in Panama City Monday.

"What we're really trying to do is build," Christopher said. "Mike was nice enough to give us these games. It's a heck of a recruiting tool."

After the games, Christopher thanked Martin, whom he described as "a cocky son of a gun" when Martin was a junior college All-American.

"He was one of those guys who would stand on first and yell to the pitcher, 'I'm goin' down!'" Christopher said. "And then he'd do it."

Fischer did some pitching in the first game. Used mainly as a reliever his first two seasons, the junior left-hander pitched the first five innings, allowing just one hit. Tim Phillips and Keith Parenteau finished up.

Figueredo went 3-for-3 at the plate for the Seminoles, while Jim Weaver and Craig Ramsey, who hit his second homer of the season, each drove in a pair of runs.

FSU next plays Thursday afternoon at 3 in a doubleheader against Missouri-Rolla.
