

Tulane dumps Seminoles in 11

NEW ORLEANS — Sam Dozier singled home John Zelenka with the winning run in the bottom of the 11th inning as Metro rival Tulane clipped Florida State 3-2 here Monday afternoon.

Three innings earlier, Dozier had driven in Zelenka to tie the score 2-2 in the bottom of the eighth.

Green Wave pitcher Joey Pursell went the distance against the Seminoles, scattering eight hits and striking out seven to raise his record to 5-1.

Florida State jumped on top early, with Lionel Martinez scoring on an infield groundout by Mike Fuentes. Martinez reached base on a walk, reached second on an error, and went to third on a grounder by Don DeLoach.

Tulane came back to tie the score in the sixth when David Stokes doubled, went to third on a wild pitch and scored on a double play.

The Seminoles regained the lead in the top of the eighth when DeLoach doubled, went to third on a Fuentes single and scored on Jim Weaver's sacrifice fly.

But Zelenka and Dozier brought the Green Wave back with their late-inning heroics.

Zelenka walked and moved to third on two groundouts before Dozier drove him in with a two-out single.

In the 11th, Zelenka singled and went to third on a single by Karl Scheurman. No. 3 batter David Stokes

was intentionally walked, but Dozier singled for the win.

The victory raised Tulane's record to 17-6, while Florida State dropped to 18-5. The Seminoles remain in New Orleans today for a night game against the University of New Orleans.

Rick Hatcher took the loss for FSU, pitching 3½ innings of relief. He is now 4-2.

Ken Fisher pitched into the eighth for Florida State, allowing two runs on six hits.

DeLoach had three of the Seminoles' eight hits. Dozier, a catcher, had three hits for the Green Wave.
