Seminoles dominate USF again

TAMPA — Florida State's baseball team stretched its winning streak to 12 games Saturday, sweeping a doubleheader from South Florida.

The Seminoles rode the four-hit pitching of Rick Hatcher to a 3-1 victory in the opener, then pounded out a 14-3 win in the second game.

The two victories gave Florida State a three-game sweep of the Golden Brahmans (14-19) and a 30-5 record going into a twogame series against Florida this week.

"The best things about the series were that we got good pitching and didn't make an error," Florida State Coach Mike Martin said.
"That's what we need down the stretch."

In Saturday's first game, the Seminoles took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning when Mike Weaver's two-out single drove in Lionel Martinez.

South Florida came back with a run in the bottom of the inning to make it 1-1. Virnce Ferlita doubled, moved to third on an infield out and scored on a wild pitch by Hatcher.

Florida State went back on top in the second. Bruce Huff reached on a fielder's choice, stole second and scored on a single by Marti-

The Seminoles added a run in the seventh when Rick Figueredo singled, stole second, went to third on an infield out and scored on a bunt single by Don DeLoach.

Hatcher had little trouble with South Florida after the first inning. The junior righthander pushed his record to 6-2 with the victory.

In the second game, South Florida jumped to a 3-0 lead in the first inning as FSU starter John Wolfer gave up three hits and a pair of walks.

The Seminoles were silent until the fourth inning, but scored 14 runs over the next four frames to put the game

In the fourth, Mike Yastrzemski laced a two-out, bases-loaded triple to

right-center field to tie the score 3-3.

In the fifth, Weaver doubled in De-Loach to put Florida State up 4-3.
Catcher Craig Ramsey then belted a two-run homer for a 6-3 FSU lead.

The onslaught continued with four runs in the sixth and four more in the seventh. Weaver hit his 14th home run of the season, a two-run blast in the

sixth.
Florida State next plays Florida in Gainesville Tuesday night at 7:30 and again Wednesday afternoon at 3:30.
