Seminoles dump UF 2-1 in 10th

GAINESVILLE — Florida State's Don DeLoach lined a single into left field to score Lionel Martinez with the winning run in the top of the 10th inning, lifting the Seminoles past the University of Florida 2-1 Tuesday night at Perry Field.

In the bottom of the 10th, Seminole reliever Ken Smith preserved FSU's one-run lead by striking out two Gator batters with the bases loaded.

The victory, in front of 1,682 Gator fans, extended FSU's winning streak to 13 games and record to 31-5. The Gators are now 30-9.

The teams meet again today at 3 p.m. Left-hander Ken Fisher (4-0) will pitch for FSU, going against right-hander Carlos Moreno (3-1).

Tuesday night's contest "was as exciting a college game as I've been involved in for awhile," Florida State Coach Mike Martin said. "I just hope everybody paid to get in here tonight, because it was well worth it."

For a while, it appeared the Gators would snap FSU's victory streak. Florida starter Rob Murphy flirted with a no-hitter through seven innings until pinch hitter George Tebbetts lined a single up the middle to begin the eighth inning.

The Gators had taken a 1-0 lead on right fielder Craig McGraw's thirdinning home run.

FSÜ tied the game in the top of the ninth. Mike Fuentes led off with a walk, moved to third on Jim Weaver's single and scored on Craig Ramsey's sacrifice fly.

One inning later, Martinez tripled off Murphy with two outs. Joe Majer relieved Murphy and promptly gave up a single to DeLoach as Martinez crossed with the winning run.

Seminole starter Ed Schneider (7-0) pitched 9 ½ innings, giving up just five hits. In the bottom of the 10th, he walked Steve Floyd and Steve Lombardozzi with one out before Martin called on Smith.

Smith walked Tony Stevens intentionally to load the bases, then struck out David Baines and pinch hitter David Falcone to pick up his second save of the season.
