## FSU nine wins 15th straight

Florida State's baseball team breezed to its 15th straight victory Sunday afternoon, shellacking Flagler College 12-1 at Seminole Field.

FSU's 33rd victory on 38 games was never in doubt as the Seminoles jumped to a 5-0 lead in the first three innings and coasted to the victory.

Leading the way were first baseman Jeff Ledbetter, who had four hits, and left fielder Jim Weaver, who smacked his 16th home run of the season.

Three Seminole pichers allowed the visitors nine hits. Dick Wiggins worked the first four innings, while Rick Hatcher, 7-2, went the next four and picked up the victory. Reliever Ken Smith pitched the

Reliever Ken Smith pitched the ninth inning, allowing Flagler, 24-11, its only run.

The Seminoles jumped to a 2-0 lead in the first when Lionel Martinez singled and and scored on Don De-Loach's triple. With two outs, Ledbetter singled in DeLoach for a 2-0 FSU lead.

In the Florida State third, Mike Fuentes doubled with two outs and scored on a single by Weaver. Ledbetter then doubled in Weaver and scored on an error by Flagler center fielder Gary Wilson.

Weaver connected for his 16th homer as the Seminoles scored four runs in the seventh inning.

Florida State's next game is at Auburn Tuesday night.
