FSU splits a pair

STATESBORO, Ga. — Finishing a game started Tuesday night, Florida State came back from a 6-0 deficit Wednesday to defeat Georgia South-

ern 13-11.

In the regularly scheduled game that followed, the Eagles won 8-3 to salvage a victory in the three-game series.

The Seminoles ended their regular season with a 48-10 record. They will play next in the NCAA South Regionals at Seminole Field May 23-25.

Georgia Southern, keeping faint hopes alive for an at-large bid to an NCAA regional, finished at 37-19.

The first game was resumed in the third inning with Georgia Southern holding a 1-0 lead. It had been suspended Tuesday night when the light system failed at Eagle Field in the second game of a scheduled twi-night doubleheader. FSU won the first game 5-3.

In the fourth inning of the suspended game, the Eagles tallied five runs to go ahead 6-0. The big hit was Steve Peruso's grand slam off Tim Phillips, who had just come in to relieve FSU

starter David Smalley.

However, Phillips was the pitcher of record when the Seminoles scored six runs in the fifth inning and six more in the sixth. It was the first victory of the season for the junior, a graduate of Godby High.

Four walks by Eagles reliever Bob Elliot opened the gates for FSU in the sixth. Carlos Colon came in and surrendered run-scoring hits to Lionel Martinez, Don DeLoach, Mike Fuentes and Mike Yastrzemski.

Yastrzemski added a two-run dou-

ble in the next inning and drove in three runs in all. Jeff Ledbetter also had three RBI and three hits.

The Eagles scored single runs in the fifth and sixth, but the Seminoles pushed across a single tally in the seventh inning to take a 13-8 lead.

But Georgia Southern made it

close, scoring three runs off Ken Smith and Rick Hatcher in the bottom of the seventh and final inning.

In the second game, the Eagles' Chuck Lusted won his tenth game of the season while his teammates were pounding 12 hits in the first five innings off FSU starter Ed Schneider.

It was the third straight defeat for Schneider, who had won his first eight

in a row.

Yastrzemski had three hits for FSU to complete a 5-for-6 afternoon.
