## FSU sweeps Georgia State

Mike Fuentes' one-out single in the eighth inning of the nightcap lifted Florida State to an 8-7 victory Thursday for a doubleheader sweep of Georgia State at Seminole Field.

Earlier, before a crowd of 829 that had dwindled to less than 100 by the time of Fuentes' hit, the Seminoles posted a 19-3 victory over the Panthers, who were playing their first games of the season. FSU, which had dropped from third to 17th in Collegiate Baseball magazine's national poll after losing its first two games, improved to 3-2.

FSU led 6-3 after four innings of the second game before the Panthers reached Seminole starter David Smalley for a pair of fifth-inning runs. Rick Hatcher came on to record the last out of the fifth and eventually

picked up the victory.

After a scoreless sixth inning, Georgia State's Jim Hutcheson led off the seventh with a towering fly ball that FSU right fielder Mike Yastrzemski lost in the twilight. With FSU playing for a bunt, Greg Giles drilled a shot past FSU third baseman Rick Figueredo. Two outs later, Pete Diffins lined a single to score both runners.

FSU tied the score in its half of the inning when Fuentes walked, stole second (for the second time in the game) and scored on a single by Jeff Ledbetter.

After the Panthers were set down in the first extra inning, Martinez and Don DeLoach singled, setting the stage for Fuentes' game-winning hit.

The first game was a rollicking affair in which FSU left fielder Joe Licata, a transfer from Indian River Community College, broke the FSU single-game record for doubles by stroking four. Licata had tied the record with his third double in a 10-run fourth inning.

In that inning, FSU sent 15 batters to the plate, highlighted by Ledbetter's grand slam, his third home run of the season. Earlier, Figuredo, who hit only two homers last season.

stroked an opposite-field home run for three of his game-high six RBI.
