Dolphins end FSU's streak

The Jacksonville University baseball team ended Florida State's winning streak at seven games Wednesday, as the Dolphins struck for six runs in the fourth inning and held on for a 10-9 decision.

Trailing 2-1 going into the fourth, Jacksonville parleyed six hits into six runs; Rick Scheetz's two-run horner was the big blow.

The Dolphins added a pair of runs in the fifth and one in the seventh inning, but FSU ground away at the lead with two runs in the fifth, one each in the sixth and seventh and two in the eighth to trail by two, 10-8, going into the top of the ninth.

The Seminoles managed to push one more across the plate, but with two out and the potential tying run at first base, Jacksonville's Larry Jackson, pitching in relief of Wade Scarboro, struck out Mike Cullen end the inning and claim the victory for the Dolphins, 3-7.

FSU's Mike Fuentes blasted two home runs in the fame, and Joe Licata and Chris Cawthon had a homer apiece for the Seminoles.

Florida State, 7-3, now travels to

the University of Miami to play a three-game series against the Hurricanes on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
