## UM slips past FSU in 10th

MIAMI — Tony Barquin scored a run in the bottom of the 10th inning on a Florida State throwing error to lift the University of Miami Hurricanes to a 4-3 victory Friday night.

Barquin singled to lead off the 10th, and moved to second when reliever Rick Hatcher hit Scott Parsons. Pinch-hitter Mike Kutner laid down a bunt to third base that was fielded by Rick Figueredo, whose throw to first base was low.

The ball got past FSU first baseman Jeff Ledbetter, allowing Bar-

quin to score.

The game, witnessed by a record crowd of 5,651, was Miami's 13th of the season without a loss. Florida State fell to 7-4.

The teams meet again tonight at 7:30 and on Sunday at 2 p.m.

Florida State opened the scoring in the top of the first. With two out, Mike Fuentes, playing before a hometown crowd, nailed a Neal Heaton fastball over the center-field fence for his sixth home run of the season.

Miami retaliated in the third to take a 2-1 lead on the strength of back-to-back triples and a bloop sin-

With one out, Miami third baseman Mike Pagliarulo slammed a Clem Freeman curve off the right-field fence. Mitch Seoane followed with another triple, a rope to right-center that scored Pagliarulo. Miami took a 2-1 lead when Bill Wrona blooped a run-scoring single to right.

The Seminoles tied the score in the fourth. With two out, designated hitter Chris Cawthon struck out — but the ball, ruled a wild pitch, rolled back to the fence as Cawthon reached base safely. Cawthon stole second and scored on a ground-rule double by catcher Craig Ramsey.

Ramsey hit a grounder down the right-field line that appeared to be playable by first baseman Alex DeJesus. But the ball moved past DeJesus and rolled down the line, where it became lodged in the right-field fence.

Heaton went all 10 innings and finished with 14 strikeouts.
