

# Hatcher pitches Seminoles past Louisville 10-1

Florida State bullpen ace Rick Hatcher made his first start of the season Sunday night and pitched the Seminoles to a 10-1 victory over Louisville.

Earlier Sunday, the Seminoles pounded Wingate College 15-5.

The victories gave Florida State an 11-8 record.

The Seminoles continue a long homestand today, taking on Ripon College in a 5 p.m. doubleheader.

Florida State plays 12 games in the next 10 days, all at Seminole Field.

Hatcher, who had a 1-2 record and four saves in 13 previous appearances, gave up only three hits and one run in seven innings.

Jay Keeler came on and shut out the Cardinals over the final two innings.

Florida State jumped to a 2-0 lead in the first inning. Lionel Martinez walked, went to second on a single by Don DeLoach and scored on a single by Mike Fuentes. Consecutive walks to Joe Licata and Jeff Ledbetter forced in the second run.

The Seminoles made it 5-0 with three runs in the second. After Dick Howser was hit by a pitch, Danny Dowell tripled to deep left center to score the first run. Martinez then hit grounder that shortstop Bob Ditommaso booted, allowing Dowell to score.

Fuentes reached on another error by Ditommaso and Licata singled to load the bases.

Mike Yastrezemski then walked to force in Martinez with the fifth Florida State run.

In the top of the fifth inning, Dave Jackson slugged a solo home run to score Louisville's lone run.

Florida State struck for three runs in the bottom of the inning. Yastrezemski walked before Figueredo unloaded with his second home run of the season. Dowell then walked, stole second, moved to third on a wild pitch and scored on a groundout by DeLoach.

Chris Cawthon belted a solo home run in the seventh. After back-to-back walks to Martinez and DeLoach, Ditommaso committed his third error of the game to let in another run.

Hatcher allowed Louisville only seven baserunners, four on walks, he struck out eight.

Against Wingate, Joe Licata cracked a three-run homer in the first inning to get the Seminoles off and running.

Florida State blew the game open in the second, sending 13 hitters to the plate and scoring seven runs. The big blow was a grand slam by Jeff Ledbetter, his eight home run of the season. Ken Huff added a solo homer.

Freshman right-hander Jeff Gray, 1-0, pitched eight innings. He gave up a two-run homer to Jeff Tuttle in the third inning. Three runs, all unearned, scored in the fourth when the Seminoles committed three errors.

Carl Ferraro pitched the ninth inning. He allowed two baserunners, on a walk and a single.

The Seminoles drew 689 fans for the first game of the split doubleheader. The count was 582 for the second contest.
