

# Fuentes helps Seminoles roll to 7th straight

Mike Fuentes had two hits, including an inside-the-park home run, as Florida State exploded for 10 runs in the first inning Wednesday night to bury Campbellsville College 19-4 at Seminole Field.

FSU boosted its record to 16-8 with its seventh straight victory. The Seminoles will play a doubleheader against Otterbein College of Ohio today at 5 p.m.

Campbellsville, an NAIA school with an enrollment of 600, is 2-5.

The Seminoles sent 15 batters to the plate in the first inning, scoring nine runs before the first out. Fuentes, who had a single in that first outburst, picked up his 11th home run with one out when his towering fly ball to right-center was misjudged by right fielder Rusty Broughton.

Fuentes added a two-run homer in the fifth inning.

"I'm way ahead of last year's pace," said Fuentes, who has 12 home runs as he caresses his school record of 29 set last year. "Last year at this time, when we were playing the weaker teams, I was still recovering from the flu. But this year I'm healthy and I just feel good hitting the ball."

FSU added four runs in the fifth, three in the sixth and one in the seventh and eighth. In the sixth inning, all three runs came on Jeff Ledbetter's

10th home run of the season, a three-run blast. Senior Ken Huff, who had not had a home run in three previous seasons, clubbed his second in four days in the seventh inning.
