

Subs spark Seminoles to 15-5 win

ATLANTA — Substitute outfielder Ken Huff laced three hits, including a ninth-inning home run, to push Florida State to a 15-5 victory over Georgia State Friday afternoon.

The Seminoles, winners of 15 of their last 17 games, are 24-10. Georgia State is 9-14.

The teams meet again today and Sunday. Both games start at 2 p.m.

Left-hander Ken Fischer (2-1) will start today for Florida State. Left-

hander Ed Schneider (4-2) is scheduled for Sunday.

Huff, playing center field in place of Mike Fuentes, drove in four runs and scored twice. His three-run homer capped a ninth-inning burst in which Florida State scored seven runs on three hits, an error, a walk and a wild pitch.

Before that, with regular starters Fuentes, Joe Licata and Lionel Mar-

tinez taking a day off, FSU had claimed an 8-5 lead, scoring runs in each of the first five innings.

Licata was replaced in left field by Chris Cawthon, who had a hit and scored three times.

Mark Barineau, who had two hits and scored two runs, filled in at second base for Martinez.

Left-hander David Smalley, 2-0, picked up the win, allowing five hits and four runs (three of them unearned) in 5½ innings.

Right-handers Tim Phillips and Jay Keeler worked the final 3½ innings, allowing only two hits and one run.

Alan Warnock (0-1), the first of four Georgia State pitchers, was tagged with the loss, giving up five runs (three unearned) over the first 3½ innings.

Florida State committed three errors in the contest, pushing its season total to 74.
