Wave rolls 15-4 over Seminoles

NEW ORLEANS — Tulane exploded for 11 runs in the first two innings Sunday and coasted to a 15-4 victory over Florida State.

The victory was Tulane's second in the three-game series and dropped Florida State's record to 27-14. The Green Wave is 22-9.

Florida State's Mark Lacy stretched his hitting streak to 19 games with a single in the eighth inning, tying the school record set by Dick Gold in 1969.

Seminole starter Rick Hatcher was rocked for eight runs — all earned before being lifted with none out in the second inning. The Green Wave continued its barrage against releivers David Smalley and Jamie Shouppe and finished with 14 base hits and 13 walks.

Hatcher's control problems got him in trouble from the start. The senior right-hander walked the first three batters he faced, then gave up a two-run single to to Sam Dozier.

Another walk loaded the bases, and two more runs scored on a fielder's choice and a bunt single.

The Green Wave batted around in the second inning, chasing Hatcher and scoring seven runs. A walk and three singles gave Tulane a 6-0 lead and brought Smalley in from the bullpen. The Green Wave stretched the lead to 11-0 before Smalley ended the uprising.

The Seminoles scored a pair of unearned runs in the fourth inning on three straight walks and a two-run error by Tulane third baseman Billy Hrappmann.

Florida State scored single runs in the eighth and ninth innings. Singles by Jeff Ledbetter and Lacy and a walk to Mike Yastrzemski loaded the bases in the eighth. Ledbetter scored from third when Joe Licata grounded into a double play.

In the ninth, Lionel Martinez singled and scored the Seminoles' fourth "run on an error.
