FSU blasts three homers in routing Valdosta 14-6

Florida State cracked three homers and took advantage of 12 walks and three errors Monday night to post a 14-6 victory over Valdosta State at Seminole Field.

The victory was the Seminoles' sixth straight and boosted their record to 41-18. Valdosta State fell to 33-12.

Chris Cawthon smashed a two-run homer in the second inning to give FSU a 2-1 lead. A solo homer by Mike Fuentes in the third, his 23rd of the season and 60th of his career, made it 3-1.

Valdosta State picked up a run in the fourth when Bobby Roche, who had three of the Blazers' nine hits, singled and later scored on a single by John Vunovich.

FSU tallied four runs in the fifth on three singles and three consecutive walks.

FSU travels to Auburn for a twogame series today and Wednesday.
