After yielding two runs in the first inning on a pair of triples by Mark Cooper and Mark Howie, Gray gave up just two hits over the next seven innings. In moving to 7-2 on the season, Gray struck out three and walked only one.

"They hit my fastball hard in the first inning. After that I started to use my slider," Gray said. "The hitters were pounding the balls into the ground, and that's when I know I am on."

While Gray was pitching, the Tigers hit into 16 ground-outs and put just five fly balls into the air.

"There's not much I can say except for the guys played a great game today," said FSU coach Mike Martin. "We got both the timely hitting and a super pitching job from Jeff Gray. Fazzini has been nothing short of phenomenal."

Florida State closes out the LSU series with a game set for 8 p.m. EST. It can be heard on WTNT radio, 1270 AM.
