Florida State 8, Duke 5

TALLAHASSEE -- Ninth-ranked Florida State opened its 1991 baseball season with an 8-5 victory over Duke Friday afternoon at Dick Howser Stadium before a crowd of 2,647.

The Seminoles scored five runs in the first inning off Duke starter Lenny Nieves, 0-1. In the inning, Nieves walked two and gave up four hits, including a run-scoring single by Nandy Serrano.

Serrano was FSU's offensive leader on the day with three hits in four at bats and a pair of runs batted in. Pedro Grifol was the only other Seminole with more than one hit.

Serrano's former teammate at Gulf Coast Community College, Tim Davis, picked up the win for FSU with 3.2 innings of one-hit pitching in relief of Seminole starter Roger Bailey. Davis entered with the bases loaded in the third and worked out of that jam, then pitched three scoreless innings before giving way to Kenny Robinson in the seventh. Robinson struck out six Blue Devils in his three innings of work to record his first save.

The offensive star for Duke was shortstop Mike Olexa. Olexa plated a pair of runs with a single in the third inning, and added a two-run homer in the seventh for a total of four RBI.

FSU and Duke continue the series Saturday with a game at 2 p.m.
