Florida State 6, Mercer 2

TALLAHASSEE -- Link Jarrett went 2-for-3 with an RBI double and Pedro Grifol's bases-loaded single scored two to lift Florida State to a 6-2 victory over Mercer before a crowd of 1,783 at Dick Howser Stadium Tuesday night.

The top-ranked Seminoles won their 19th straight game and improved to 29-3 on the season. FSU has won 30 consecutive home games dating back to the 1990 season. Mercer dropped to 9-15 with the loss.

The bottom third of FSU's order produced two-out runs in both the second and fourth innings off Bear starter and loser Blake Horne, 0-3. In the second, Kenny Felder walked with two outs and went to third on a single by Link Jarrett. He scored on Garrett Blanton's double. In the fourth, Felder singled with two outs and came all the way around to score on Jarrett's double to the gap.

Mercer came back with a run in its half of the sixth off FSU starter Bryan Harris, who allowed only three hits in six innings and struck out seven to pick up his third victory of the year. The Bears got their only run off Harris when Casey Green singled, went to second on a sacrifice bunt by Todd McCain and scored on Kyle Rose' double.

Harris was replaced in the seventh by Ricky Kimball, who struck out the first five batters he faced and picked up his third save of the year with six strikeouts over three innings.

The Seminoles broke the game open in the seventh with the help of a pair of Mercer errors. Both Blanton and Allen Bevis reached on errors to start the inning. After a groundout to first, Eduardo Perez was intentionally walked to load the bases, bringing up FSU RBI leader Grifol. The junior catcher promptly sent reliever Darius Solomon's offering up the middle for a two-run single. Ty Mueller's grounder to short plated another run and Grifol scored on a wild pitch to complete the scoring. All four runs in the inning were unearned.


Kimball closed out the game for FSU although Mercer picked up another run on a single by John Callihan and double by Marcus Garcia with two outs in the ninth.

In addition to Jarrett's two hits, Perez had a single and a double to pace FSU. Garcia was the only Bear with more than one hit.
