QUOTES FROM HEAD COACH MIKE MARTIN, FLORIDA STATE

"It was ~~XX~~ ballgame that I thought we would score 9-10 runs with the wind blowing out and they were throwing a lefthander.

"We were just hoping John could get us to the seventh for Ricky, but he kept getting them out and he took us into the ninth.

"It's a very emotional time for me because this ballclub is one of the ones I'll always remember because of the camaraderie of this team. This ball club has been a joy.

(On putting Brock in for Felder)

"After his (Kenny's) first two at-bats, I thought we needed a change. I made the move two innings before and decided to stay with it. Brock hit a heck of a pitch -- that split finger change.

CHRIS BROCK

"I knew the inning before that he was gonna put me in. It was a split finger fastball and I was just trying to get it in play. I was lucky enough that it fell for me.

RICKY KIMBALL

"Our bullpen catcher Jon Bolin said 'man, they've got to get you in the game' and of course I agreed with him. I felt like I had good stuff.

(On the feeling) Yeah -- Finally yeah. I wanted to say I've been to the world series twice. I wanted to end my career here, ~~XXXXXX~~ winning the regional, not with the regular season.

PEDRO GRIFOL

"John knew, everyone knew he had to throw 5-6 innings. John knew what he had to do and he went out and did it. Ricky came in and had good stuff. He's got a lot of experience and he's a guy you want on the mound in that situation.

"We're gonna go out there and play and play hard. Hopefully, things will happen for us.

ALABAMA HEAD COACH BARRY SHOLLENBERGER

"I congratulate Mike Martin and Florida State on a great tournament. I'm not an expert on the world series but I've been there and I saw things in Florida State's team that makes me think they could make a real move in Omaha. They've got the ingredients it takes to win out there. They were patient and played well even though we got on top of them twice. They got good pitching, timely hitting and didn't panic. They have the ability to go to the bullpen and not just shut us down, but at times dominated.
