Duke 5, Florida State 4

TALLAHASSEE -- Duke scored four unearned runs in the third inning and held on to upset fifth-ranked Florida State 5-4 in college baseball action Saturday in Tallahassee. A crowd of 1,601 saw the favored Seminoles lose their five-game win streak. Florida State lost only its second home game in the last 47 games at Dick Howser Stadium.

The loss dropped Florida State's record to 8-2, 1-1 in the Atlantic Coast Conference while Duke improved to 3-1, 1-1.

Duke's Scott Pinoni put the Blue Devils ahead to stay with a three-run homer off FSU starter and loser John Wasdin, 0-1, in the third. Cass Hopkins, who had three hits on the day to lead the Blue Devils, started the inning with an infield single and advanced all the way to third on a passed ball. He scored when Quinton McCracken's bunt attempt was thrown away by FSU catcher Marc Dunbar. After a walk and a pop out, Pinoni blasted a 2-2 pitch from Wasdin to give the Blue Devils an insurmountable lead.

FSU chipped away with a single run in the third and a pair of runs in the fourth off Duke starter and winner Ryan Jackson, 1-0. Chris Brock's triple scored both runs in the fourth while Chris Roberts had an RBI single in the third.

Hopkins scored Duke's final run in the sixth. He singled, stole second and scored on McCracken's single to right.

FSU scored one in the seventh on Allen Bevis' double to close the margin to 5-4. But Duke relievers Phil Harrell and Mike Kotarski shut the door in the eighth and ninth.

The two teams conclude the three-game series Sunday at 2 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
