OSCAR MAYER BASEBALL CLASSIC

Mississippi State vs. Florida State

Sunday, March 1, 1992

Junior lefthander Chris Roberts pitched a complete game, four-hitter and helped his own cause with an RBI single in the seventh inning to lead Florida State (11-3) to a 5-1 victory over Mississippi State (1-2) in the Oscar Mayer Classic finale at the Metrodome Sunday.

Florida State and Texas A&M (12-5) finished with identical 2-1 records in the three-day round robin tournament, but Texas A&M claimed the title due to a 9-1 victory over the Seminoles Saturday. Host Minnesota (5-4) and Mississippi State finished with 1-2 marks in the tournament.

Senior third baseman Nandy Serrano had two hits in three trips to the plate, with a pair of RBI's, to help pace Florida State to the victory. Mississippi State's senior third baseman Charlie Anderson broke up Roberts' shutout bid with a solo home run to lead off the ninth inning.

1st Inning - **Florida State (1)** - Grady Jordan led off with a single to left. Nandy Serrano was hit by a pitch. Chris Roberts sacrifice bunt, pitcher to first, Jordan advanced to third, Serrano to second. Ty Mueller sacrifice bunt, pitcher to first, Jordan scored, Serrano to third. Chris Brock flew out to right to end the inning.

7th Inning - **Florida State (2)** - Colby Weaver hit a double down the left field line to open the inning. Grady Jordan sacrifice bunt, pitcher to first, Weaver advanced to third. Jay Powell relieves Daniel on the mound. Nandy Serrano walked. Chris Roberts singled, Weaver scored and Serrano advanced to third. Ty Mueller struck out. Double steal on the pitch, Roberts stole second, Serrano came home on the throw to second and then Roberts advanced to third when the ball got away from the catcher. Chris Brock flied out to end the inning.

8th Inning - **Florida State (2)** - Kevin McCray drew a lead-off walk. Link Jarrett walked, McCray to second. Tony Liebsack bunted, but McCray was forced at third. Colby Weaver reached on an infield single to load the bases...Grady Jordan looked at a called third strike. Nandy Serrano hits an infield single, Jarrett and Liebsack scored, Weaver goes to third on a throwing error on the first baseman...Chris Roberts struck out to end the inning.

9th Inning - **Mississippi State (1)** - Charlie Anderson led off the inning with a home run to left center. Jay Powell struck out. Steve Hegan lined out to left center. Ron Brown grounded out, short to first, to end the game.

TEXAS A&M'S MARSHALL NAMED TOURNAMENT MVP

Senior shortstop Jason Marshall of Texas A&M was honored as the MVP of the Oscar Mayer Classic which concluded on Sunday at the Metrodome in Minneapolis. He went 6-for-12 at the plate with four RBI's to lead the Aggies to the tournament title.

Minnesota junior first baseman George Behr won the Easton Silver Sticks Award which goes to the player in the tournament with the best batting average. He had six hits in 12 at-bats, with four doubles, a home run and five RBI's to lead the Golden Gophers. Although Behr and Marshall both had identical batting averages of .500, Behr won the award due to more RBI's.
