Florida State 6, North Carolina 3

TALLAHASSEE -- Mike Martin singled with two outs and the bases loaded in the fifth to bring FSU back from behind and lead the Seminoles to a 6-3 win over Atlantic Coast Conference foe North Carolina.

The victory improved Florida State's record to 14-3, 1-0 in the ACC. North Carolina fell to 9-4, 0-1.

Paul Wilson, who improved his record to 5-0 with the win, scattered 12 hits over nine innings, struck out eight and walked only one. The Orlando native went the distance for the second time in as many outings.

Florida State trailed 3-2 when Martin came to the plate with two outs and the bases loaded in the fifth. The sophomore catcher laced a single to right to score Chad Sheffer, who was hit by a pitch, and Grady Jordan, who had singled. Mickey Lopez followed Martin with a single as FSU took a 5-3 lead in the fifth off UNC starter and loser Derek Manning, 2-2.

Jordan scored three times and picked up a pair of hits for FSU. Doug Mientkiewicz drove in Jordan in both the first and third innings with singles. Lopez also had a pair of hits, including an eighth-inning double, for Florida State.

Catcher Chris Madonna went 3-for-4 with a double to lead North Carolina. David Boone also picked up a pair of hits and scored two runs for the Tar Heels. RBI singles by Boone and Mitch Jones gave UNC a 3-2 lead in the fourth before Florida State's comeback in the fifth.

Florida State and North Carolina continue the three-game series Saturday at 7 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium with freshman righthander Jonathan Johnson (2-0) on the mound for the Seminoles.
