Florida State 8, Virginia 1

TALLAHASSEE -- Florida State extended its winning streak to five games and kept its Atlantic Coast Conference record perfect with an 8-1 victory over Virginia Thursday before a crowd of 871 in Tallahassee. The win gave FSU a three-game sweep of the Cavaliers for a 5-0 ACC record. The Tribe is 18-3 overall.

Junior John Wasdin scattered seven singles, walked one and struck out eight in seven innings to pick up his fourth win of the season without a loss. John Nedeau and Phil Olson finished up on the mound for FSU.

Florida State scored one run in the first on Mike Martin's sacrifice fly. The Seminoles added a pair of runs in both the third and fourth, and single runs in the fifth, seventh and eighth.

Seven players drove in runs for FSU while eight picked up at least one hit. Doug Mientkiewicz and Ty Mueller were the only FSU players with two hits. Grady Jordan's solo home run to lead off the fourth accounted for Florida State's only extra-base hit of the day. UVA starter John Cappelmann (1-1) gave up the first five Florida State runs to take the loss.

Shawn Mitchell was the only Cavalier with more than one hit on the day as he stroked a pair of singles. UVA opened the seventh with three straight hits, Mark Post driving in Jason Cook with Virginia's only run.

Virginia (8-8, 0-4) travels to Athens, Ga. for a two-game set with Georgia this weekend. Florida State takes on Northern Iowa in a three-game series beginning Friday at 7 p.m. at Dick Howser Stadium.
