Florida State 5, N.C. State 1

RALEIGH, N.C. -- Florida State battled rain and seventh-ranked North Carolina State before coming away with a 5-1 Atlantic Coast Conference baseball victory over the Wolfpack in front of a crowd of 1,700 at Doak Field in Raleigh.

Seminole pitcher Paul Wilson (7-1) allowed only three hits and no runs over the first six innings to pick up his seventh win of the year. John Nedeau pitched the final three frames for his second save of the season.

The win evened the three-game series at one apiece and upped FSU's record to 25-5, 8-2 in the ACC. N.C. State fell to 24-3, 5-1.

The Seminoles took a 1-0 lead in the fourth inning on Mike Schmitz' two-out single just before the first rain delay, which lasted 28 minutes. Two innings later, Florida State added to its lead on Mickey Lopez' two-run single. All three runs came off Wolfpack starter and loser Shawn Senior, 6-1, who allowed only two hits, but walked six in five innings.

Following a rain delay of 1:06, the Tribe added single runs in the seventh and eighth off NCSU relievers. N.C. State plated its only run in the seventh on an RBI groundout by Tim Tracey.

Five different players collected singles for Florida State while Ryan Ferby picked up two of N.C. State's five hits on the day.

The two teams conclude the series, and Florida State finishes a six-game road trip, Sunday at 1 p.m.
