Tallahassee, FL - The seventh-ranked Florida State Seminoles pounded out 13 hits en route to an 11-2 victory over Mercer at Dick Howser Stadium Wednesday night.

The game was a continuation of Tuesday night's suspended contest. When play resumed, FSU was leading 2-0 with the bases-loaded and no outs in the bottom of the first inning.

Florida State picked up where it left off, sending nine batters to the plate in jumping out to an early 4-0 lead. With the win FSU improves its record to 25-6, while Mercer fell to 6-19.

The Seminoles were led offensively by T.R. Marcinczyk, who belted his third home run of the year and added a double in a four RBI performance. The Tribe also collected round-trippers from Mike Schmitz and Danny Kanell.

Starter and loser Don Hanson (0-2) was one of seven Mercer pitchers used in the game. Florida State's Bryan Harris took the hill in the top of the second in relief of starter Steven Morgan. Harris scattered two hits over five innings, allowing one run, in upping his record to 4-2.

FSU added two runs in the second on a Ty Mueller single. Schmitz homered in the third giving FSU a 7-0 lead. The Tribe used the advantage to play all available personnel as 22 players, including five pitchers, saw action.

Florida State goes on the road to play Atlantic Coast Conference foe Georgia Tech, ranked as high as third, in a three-game weekend series starting Friday.
