Florida State 13, Jacksonville 3

TALLAHASSEE -- Fourth-ranked Florida State (34-9) exploded for eight runs in the bottom of the seventh inning to pull away for a 13-3 win over visiting Jacksonville (25-21) in college baseball action Wednesday night at Dick Howser Stadium.

Ty Mueller's grand slam was the big blow as the Seminoles had their most productive inning of the year and made Head Coach Mike Martin a winner in his 1,000th game as head coach at Florida State. In his 14th season, the fourth winningest active coach in college baseball owns a 749-248-3 career mark.

FSU starter Phil Olson, who was forced into the starting role for the first time due to an illness to Steven Morgan, struck out 10 in eight innings to improve to 3-1. Olson, who had made 21 relief appearances for the Seminoles, walked just three. After allowing two unearned runs in the first inning, and an earned run in the second, the freshman righthander surrendered just one hit and fanned eight over the next six innings. Charlie Cruz pitched a perfect ninth inning in relief of Olson.

Randy Hodges, who was 3-for-3, gave Florida State the lead in the sixth with a two-run single off of JU reliever Sam Arguto (4-7). Hodges drove in three runs on the night.

Four Jacksonville pitchers combined for 14 walks on the evening, and 10 of those walks came around to score for the Seminoles.

Florida State, now a perfect 9-0 against in-state competition this year, travels to Miami on Thursday, where the Seminoles will begin a three-game series with the Hurricanes on Friday at 7:30 p.m. FSU swept a three-game series from Miami here earlier this month.
