Florida State 6, Jacksonville 1

TALLAHASSEE -- Bryan Harris scattered eight hits and struck out seven over seven innings to lead eighth-ranked Florida State to a 6-1 win over Jacksonville Wednesday night at Dick Howser Stadium.

Left fielder Ty Mueller had a pair of doubles and drove in three runs for the Seminoles, now 38-12. Jacksonville fell to 26-24.

Florida State jumped out front with two runs in the first inning. Mueller doubled off the screen in right-center to score Mickey Lopez, who had singled. Mike Schmitz followed with an RBI single to give Harris and the Seminoles a 2-0 lead.

The Dolphins cut the lead in half in the second on a single by Jason Hamilton. Hamilton, who had three hits on the night, plated Andy Holin with the visitors only run.

Colby Weaver lined his first home run of the year over the left field wall in the fourth inning to extend FSU's lead to 3-1.

Jacksonville threatened in the seventh, after FSU had built a 5-1 lead, but could not score a run despite getting three hits. Mueller gunned down Hamilton at the plate on a single by Galen Williams to end the inning.

Mueller continued his stellar night in the home half of the seventh, driving a double off the left field wall that scored Doug Mientkiewicz with the Seminoles' final run.

Mientkiewicz and Lopez each had a pair of hits for Florida State, who opens a three-game series with Atlantic Coast Conference rival Clemson here Friday night at 7 p.m.
