GEORGIA TECH GIVES FLORIDA STATE FIRST ACC LOSS WITH 4-1 VICTORY

APRIL 28, 1996

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Georgia Tech right-hander David Elder no-hit No. 4 Florida State for 7.1 innings, as the No. 18 Yellow Jackets (29-17, 9-9 ACC) defeated the Seminoles, 4-1, in front of 2,235 fans at Dick Howser Stadium.

Elder (7-3) struck out 11 batters but walked seven and held the Seminoles hitless through 7.1 innings, before yielding a hit to short leftfield by first baseman Matt Woodward.

Florida State (34-9, 17-1 ACC) scored in the second inning as catcher Jeremy Salazar drove in leftfielder Jeremy Morris on a fielder's choice to put the Seminoles ahead 1-0.

First baseman Scott Byers and shortstop Jay Hood belted back-to-back RBI-singles in the fourth inning to give Tech a 2-1 advantage. The Yellow Jackets got two insurance runs in the fifth inning with a two-run homer by right fielder Mark Fischer.

Florida State attempted a comeback in the eighth inning as J.D. Drew stepped up to the plate with two men on base, but Tech reliever L.J. Yankosky handed Drew his third strikeout on the night. Yankosky picked up his first save of the season as he shut down FSU for 1.1 innings.

FSU leftfielder Jeremy Morris tied the ACC record for doubles in a season with his 28th of the year. Morris shares the record with Ken Noe of Maryland who set the mark in 1991.

Seminole left-hander Scooby Morgan (7-2) gave up four runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings for the loss.
