

Henderson homers twice in FSU's victory

Designated hitter Terry Henderson drove in six runs on four hits, including a two-run home run, as No. 19 Florida State defeated No. 20 Wake Forest 10-4 in an Atlantic Coast Conference game on Saturday at Gene Hooks Stadium.

The victory extended FSU's winning streak to eight games.

Right-hander Jon McDonald (4-2) struck out a career-high 12 batters and scattered seven hits in his first complete game. He allowed just one walk and three earned runs.

Brian Cox had three hits and two RBIs for FSU (19-7, 3-0 ACC). Matt Diaz had three hits and drove in a run.
