Tar Heels centerfielder Jarrett Shearin drove in four runs on three hits as he led North Carolina (23-13, 75 ACC) to a 6-5 win over No. 12 Florida State (31-12, 9-2 ACC) at Boshamer Stadium in Chapel Hill, N.C.

Right-hander Derrick DePriest (4-1) allowed just one run on one hit and struck out two batters in four innings of relief to earn the win for North Carolina.

Left-hander Chris Ginn gave up one run on one hit in one inning in relief as he took the loss for the Seminoles. Right-hander Jon Mc-Donald gave up five runs on 11 hits and struck out six batters in a nodecision for FSU.

North Carolina took at 6-5 lead in the bottom of the eighth inning as rightfielder Richie Grimsley doubled and scored on a wild pitch by reliver Zach Diaz.

In the first inning, third baseman Jose Zabala walked and scored on the front end of a double steal attempt, but centerfielder Brian Cox was caught stealing to end the inning for the Seminoles.

The Tar Heels quickly tied it up at 1-1 as they ripped four consecutive hits of McDonald. Shearin singled, stole second base and advanced to third on a throwing error. Shearin then tied the score on a base-hit by designated hitter Chris LaMarsh.

Second baseman Brooks Badeaux walked and scored on a single by catcher Jeremy Salazar as the Seminoles took a 2-1 lead in the third inning. The Tar Heels tied the score at 2-2 in the bottom of the third.

Seminole designated hitter Kevin Cash belted a solo home run in the top of the fourth inning giving FSU a 3-2 advantage, but the Tar Heels quickly took a 4-3 lead on a two-run single by Shearin in the bottom of the inning.

Salazar walked and scored on a sacrifice fly by leftfielder Karl Jernigan in the sixth inning as the Seminoles tied the game at 44. Shearin and Cash traded solo home runs in the seventh and eighth innings to make the sore 5-5. Left-hander Mike Bynum surrendered four runs on three hits in five innings of a no-decision. Bynum fanned five batters and walked six in the outing.
