FSU goes two-and-out at CWS

The Seminoles return home after two games in the double-elimination tournament.

This team had set itself apart from all the others Mike Martin had coached just by reaching the College World Series.

Once there, this team proved to be like most that have represented Florida State.

A three-run blast by Scott Redfox in the seventh inning sent the Seminoles home after just two games. The 7-4 loss to Long Beach State marked the fifth time FSU

has departed the CWS 0-2.

Only Northern Colorado has lost the first two games in the CWS more times than FSU. But no school, not even Northern Colorado with 10 appearances in the CWS without a title, can match FSU's futility. The Seminoles leave Rosenblatt Stadium without a national title for the 16th time.

At least Sunday marked the return of Matt Diaz, pitcher's night-mare. After launching four homers against Oklahoma in the Atlantic II Regional, Diaz's power had been turned off for two games. But he put Caleb Balbuena's fastball into the right-field bleachers for a fourth-inning, three-run homer on Sunday. It was his 22nd homer this

Diaz's shot rode a 20-mph wind blowing from left to right. In the bottom of that inning, 49er first baseman Jason Yount would find the wind equally favorable. His solo shot to right field would make it 4-1 in the third inning.

The 49ers were not finished, but an inning later FSU starter Nick Stocks was. He gave up three runs in the fifth inning and left the game with the bases loaded and two outs. Reliever John Bentley snagged Justin Hall's shot back to the mound to get the final out as Long Beach State stranded three runners.

Bentley lived dangerously an inning later as he loaded the bases with just one out and picked up a strikeout and deep fly to escape.

The Seminoles took a 1-0 lead in the first. But the kind of thing that seems to always happen to FSU in the College World Series prevented FSU from scoring more. FSU was ahead 1-0 with runners on second and third when Caleb Balbuena sent a pitch to the backstop. The ball ricocheted sharply back into the glove of Long Beach State catcher Bryan Kennedy. Just like that, Jose Zabala was out in a rundown and the Seminole threat was over.
