NO. 1 FLORIDA STATE COMES BACK TO DEFEAT WASHINGTON STATE, 8-5

MINNEAPOLIS, MN -- Second baseman Marshall McDougall drove in three runs on three hits as he led No. 1 Florida State (16-3) to an 8-5 come-from-behind win over Washington State at the Hormel Foods Classic. McDougall was named the tournamen's most valuable player for his efforts.

Right-hander Chris Whidden (2-0) earned the win in relief after pitching the eighth inning and left-hander Mike DiBlasi struck out the side in the ninth for his fourth save of the season.

Right-hander Reggie Rivard (1-1) took the loss in relief forWashington State (9-4) after giving up three runs on four hits.

After four scoreless innings, designated hitter Zach Bode laced a three-run double to right centerfeld as the Cougars took a 3-0 lead in the fifth inning.

Florida State rallied from a 3-0 deficit to score five runs in the seventh inning. First baseman Kevin Cash led off the inning with a solo home run to right field. Centerfielder Karl Jernigan followed with a double and eventually scored on a ground ball hit by shortstop Brett Groves. Pinch-hitter John Ford Griffin reached on an error by the shortstop and both Griffin and Groves were knocked in on a home run by third baseman Marshall McDougall.

Washington State tied the game in the top of the eighth on a two-runingle by shortstop Shawn Stevenson, the Seminoles offered another come back in the bottom of the inning. Cash led off with a double and scored the game-winning run on a triple to centerfield by Jernigan. Catcher Jeremiah Klosterman knocked Jernigan on a basehit up the middle. Pinch-hitter J.C. Huguet walked and pinch-runner Nick Stocks scored on a Groves basehit as FSU took an 8-5 lead.

Right-hander Blair Varnes struck out five batters in five innings pitched in the no-decision. Varnes did not give up an earned run and surrendered six hits and one walk.

Minnesota left-hander Todd Meldahl held FSU to two runs on seven hits in six innings of a no-decision. Meldahl struck out three batters and walked three in the outing.
