## NO. 1 FLORIDA STATE KEEPS WINNING WITH 14-1 VICTORY OVER MERCER

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Rightfielder John-Ford Griffin drove in three runs on four hits and leftfielder Matt Diaz belted a three-run double in the fourth inning in No. 1 Florida State's 14-1 victory over Mercer in front of a crowd of 1,217 at Dick Howser Stadium.

The Seminoles (30-3) extended their winning streak to 16 games, while Mercer (19-13) ended a six-game winning streak.

Right-hander Mike Smalley (3-0) held the Bears to one run on six hits in his third win of the season. Smalley struck out five batters and walked four in five innings pitched.

Third baseman Kevin Cash ripped a two-run single to get the Seminoles' run parade started in the first inning. Cash recorded two hits on the day.

"I was glad to see us establish ourselves early today," said head coach Mike Martin. "Our relievers also did a great job and I especially like to see a zero in the errors column."

Second baseman Marshall McDougall extended his hitting streak to 24 games with an RBI-single in Florida State's five-run third inning.

Centerfielder Karl Jernigan added two runs to the FSU board with his fourth home run of the season in the fifth inning.

The Seminoles chased Mercer right-hander Jeff Nebel (6-1) after 2 1/3 innings after he gave up nine runs on seven hits and three walks. Nebel fanned three batters in the outing.

Bears' first baseman Brandon Blair blasted a solo home run to right field in the fourth inning.

Florida State relief pitchers combined for four scoreless innings and five strikeouts. Seminole first baseman John Halliday, who sat out today's game with a groin injury, is progressing well and is hoping to be back for this weekend's three-game series with No. 19 Wake Forest according to FSU trainer Duane Brooks.
