## NO. 1 FSU WINS 16<sup>TH</sup> STRAIGHT WITH AN 8-3 VICTORY OVER DUKE

Tallahassee, FL - Top-ranked Florida State improved to 22-2, its best start since 1990, with an 8-3 win over Duke this evening in front of 2,162 fans at Dick Howser Stadium. The Blue Devils dropped to 5-16 with the loss.

Junior RHP Mike Ziegler (5-0) had another impressive start for FSU as he pitched six scoreless innings. Ziegler allowed six hits, walked two and struck out seven.

The Seminoles scored first with a run in the bottom of the second inning. Karl Jernigan and Mike Futrell had back-to-back singles, with Jernigan coming around to score when Duke shortstop Jeff Becker mishandled a Chris Smith ground ball.

FSU added another run in the third when John-Ford Griffin doubled, moved to third on a Marshall McDougall single, and scored on Ryan Barthelemy's ground out.

In the fourth, Scott Boyd led off the inning with a double off the screen in right center. Blair McCaleb followed with a bunt base hit down the first base line to put runners on the corners. Brett Groves walked to load the bases and Griffin followed with an RBI-single to right. Barthelemy recorded the second RBI of the inning when he drew a bases loaded walk.

McCaleb made it 6-0 FSU in the fifth when he hit his first career home run over the left field wall with Boyd, who was hit by a pitch, on first.

The Blue Devils made it interesting with three runs in the top of the seventh off reliever Nick Whidden. With two outs, Gideon Thompson dropped in a base hit to right that scored Wes Goodner. J.D. Alleva homered to right with Thompson aboard to cut FSU's lead in half.

FSU responded with a pair of runs in the bottom half of the eighth. Chris Smith and Boyd started things off with walks, moving to second and third on McCaleb's sacrifice bunt. Groves then made it 8-3 with a two-run double to left center.

Groves (2-for-4), Griffin (2-for-5) and McCaleb (2-for-3) had multi-hit games for the Tribe.

LHP Kevin Perry (1-1) took the loss, giving up four runs (three earned) in three innings. Nick Whidden gave up all three runs for FSU in one inning of work. Chris Ginn and Mike DiBlasi worked a scoreless eighth and ninth.

FSU will send RHP Blair Varnes (3-1) to the mound in the final game of the series while Duke is scheduled to start RHP Ryan Caradonna (1-3). The 1:00 p.m. Sunday game will be televised by Sunshine.
