

FSU women win, men lose in CC openers

While the Florida State women dominated a meet, the men met with a harsher fate in opening the fall cross country season.

FSU's women won five of the first six places and put all seven runners in the top 10 to capture a six-team run

over a 5,000-meter course at the University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa. Kathy Moore won in a course-record time of 18.27.0, over a minute better than the old record. Nancy Jaquish finished third, Nancy McCormac fourth, Rose Gianpalmo fifth and Lisa Kinch sixth.

The men dropped a 24-35 decision on their home course Saturday against the Valdosta Blazers. Seminoles Donnie Cook and Tom Herron finished second and third to Valdosta's Joe Gorman. The only other Seminole in the top ten was Tim McClain, who finished eighth.
