

# Wills beats field at FSU Invitational

Herb Wills, Florida State sophomore, won the individual title in the Florida State Invitational cross-country run Saturday while Alabama and Florida tied for the team championship.

Wills covered the 10,000 meter layout in 31:11.0 to pace the Seminoles to third place.

The Gators and Crimson Tide deadlocked with 33 points each, with 'Bama getting the win on the basis of the higher-placing individual, while FSU came in with 63, followed by Georgia with 103 and South Alabama with 148.

UCLA won the women's division with 30 points. FSU finished second at 53, followed by Texas with 61, Alabama with 79, LSU with 140 and Santa Fe Community College with 178.

Kathy Mintie of UCLA won the 5,000 meter women's run in 16:50.5 for a new course record for women.

Kathy Moore placed sixth for FSU in 17:56.0.

In the high school division, Largo won the boys' division and DeLand took the girls' division. Mike Vackholz won the open division and Seminole Community College won the junior college division.
