

Parish Scores as FSU Seminoles

Down Sewanee 6-0

Undefeated Indians Win Tenth Straight

SEWANEE, Tenn, Oct 22, (AP)—Undefeated Florida State University punched out a fourth period touchdown to defeat the University of the South (Sewanee) 6-0 in a mountain-top football game played in fog here today.

The victory was the tenth straight for Florida State and was Sewanee's first loss of the year.

Both teams are in the vanguard of the nation's non-subsidized football squads.

Early in the fourth period Wyatt (Red) Parish, 175-pound speedster from Bonifay, swept over the

soft-footing on a 12-yard touchdown jaunt.

For the most part, the rest of the game was punt and plod, with State getting the best of things statistically.

State racked up 179 yards rushing and six passing for nine first downs. Sewanee managed only 57 yards along the ground and 23 by air for six first downs. Each team averaged 34 yards on 11 kicks by State and 10 by Sewanee.

Sewanee's line, outweighed some 20 pounds to the man, was paced by hard-cracking Nick Willard and Cotton Richardson up front. Prince McDavid made several nice runs.

Touchdown Drive

State threats in the backfield were Walter Foy and Buddy Strauss, along with Parish.

Late in the third period Parish set off the touchdown drive with a 28-yard dash haround left end to the Sewanee 43. Foy followed with a sprint to the 30. Parish added five as the quarter ended.

The heavy fog lifted somewhat when State continued the drive with a first down on the 20. Strauss hit the line for eight and then Parish circled the flank for the only touchdown of the game. Hanson's kick was no good.

State drove to the Sewanee four just before the game ended, but lost the ball on a fumble.

Sewanee drove into State territory on several occasions, but didn't have the necessary punch to score.
