Dr. Robert M. Strozier

President, Florida State University

Florida State University's President, Dr. Robert M. Strozier, is a football enthusiast who will be "playing" his third year for the Seminoles.

When Dr. Strozier came to Florida State in September, 1957, it was homecoming for the popular new president. Born in McRae, Ga., he was reared in Moultrie, Ga., and was graduated from Emory University. He earned his Ph.D. at the University of Chicago.


President Strozier began his professional career as professor of romance languages at Georgia State College for Men at Tifton. From 1933-1940 he served as professor of French and dean of men at West Georgia College.

In 1940 he went to the University of Georgia as associate dean of students and associate professor of romance languages. Later he served as director of the Army Special Training Program unit there.

In May, 1945, he joined the University of Chicago faculty as associate director of International House and in 1946 he became dean of students.

President Strozier's first two years at Florida State have been years of accomplishments. Faculty and staff morale has mounted with his enthusiasm. Alumni have rallied to the support of Florida State in increasing numbers and alumni giving is on the increase.

At Commencement last June he reported gifts and grants to the University totaling \$3,230,000 since the beginning of the academic year 1957. This compared with \$2,250,000 received between 1948 and 1957.



Perry Moss

Athletic Director and Head Football Coach
Florida State University

Before and since he pitched a surprise 44-yard pass to Julie Rykovich on the opening play of the 1947 Rose Bowl game, thereby starting a Big Ten domination at Pasadena, Perry Moss has been making headlines.

A tireless worker who was a unanimous selection to become head coach at Florida State last January, Moss has enjoyed a varied career as a player and as a coach. And, not unlike the mythical King Midas, just about everything Moss has touched has turned to success.

Only 33 years old, Moss was graduated from Tulsa's Central High School in 1944. He played one semester of football at Tulsa University in the fall of that year, playing in the Orange Bowl. After two years in the Air Force, he enrolled at Illinois in the autumn of 1946 and piloted the Illini to a Big Ten championship that year, playing a vital part in the 45-14 trouncing Illinois handed UCLA in the inaugural (1947) Rose Bowl game between the Big Ten and Pacific Coast Conference. While at Illinois, he was an All-Big Ten quarterback for the 1946 and 1947 seasons. He won honorable mention on various All-American teams in 1944, 1946, and 1947.

In 1947, Moss became the first recipient of the Nelson Award for Sportsmanship. Illinois and Iowa were deadlocked, 0-0, in a key late-season game, with the Illini driving for a touchdown. Just before the snap of the ball, an Iowa guard fainted. Moss immediately called time out to allow the opposing player to be removed from the field, thus eliminating the possibility of injury.

An optimist, Moss has a wide reputation for his ingenuity on offense. The Seminoles this fall will spring from Perry's own "Finesse Drive" attack, a composite of several types of offenses.

Perry holds a B.S. degree from Illinois and a Master's degree from Washington. He and his lovely wife (Jane) have two sons: Calvin Eugene, 8, and Perry Lee, Jr., 6.
