



Tonight !

Miami Will Show Some Muscle

Back in 1951, Miami and Florida State squared off in grid combat against each other for the first time.


It was pretty much of a lop-sided scuffle, with the Hurricanes all but blowing the Seminoles and their tomahawks out of the ball park.

The four ensuing clashes went pretty much the same way, but then the tide turned suddenly in 1958, and FSU started dominating the win picture. The Seminoles won 17 to 6 in that turning-of-the-tide game and captured four of the next seven clashes.

Tonight, Florida State will be trying to make it five in a row over the Hurricanes, but in the attempt, could run into a real buzz-saw, something they haven't seen before. Miami's young pigskinners grew up late in the second period of the Pittsburgh game last week, completely outplaying and out-scoring the nation's No. 18 ranking team. That great comeback in the last two and a half quarters against the Panthers could mean that the Hurricanes have finally jelled and will be the football team they hoped to be when the season opened in September.

One thing for certain, Miami exhibited tremendous running at Pitt when it stopped fumbling. It was Miami's finest bit of ball carrying in nearly three years.

After the Pitt was over, Coach Carl Pasqua called Walter Kichefski's team the best ball club the Panthers have played this year — even better

than UCLA, which nearly upset mighty Stanford last week.

Coach Kichefski, himself, believes his club has turned the corner. The squad gives every indication it is now able to out-muscle tough football teams — something you will see for yourself tonight.

Against Pitt, Miami began to make headway on the sweeps, which were winding up in losses in earlier games. The offensive line is beginning to deliver the blocking needed as its greenness wears off.

You can look for better passing and catching, too. Though Kelly Cochrane was intercepted four times at Pitt against three for the first four games, Pitt knew Kelly had to pass after Miami's bad start and adjusted their defense accordingly. In spite of that, Kelly had 16 completions for 196 yards. He was finger tips away from two more completions, which could have boosted his total over 300 yards for the game and might have

turned the battle into the greatest of all Miami comebacks.

That the Hurricanes did make a comeback after trailing 28-0 speaks volumes.

Florida State also played a whale of a game last week in tripping up strong South Carolina. The score of 21-13 does not reflect the difference between the clubs as the Gamecocks, after an early score, were outclassed until a consolation touchdown just before the final siren.

In between, Florida State flashed an awesome ground defense — just 58 rushing yards were all the bigger Gamecocks could muster and an adequate pass defense which stifled South Carolina passing after a slow start.

On its own side, Florida State rushed in Tommy Warren at quarterback after the game started and he rode the Seminoles to victory. He'll be the starter tonight in FSU musical chairs of quarterbacking. Tommy started FSU'S first two games this year, then gave way to Frank Whigham, who in turn gave way to Gary Huff.

When Huff failed to move the club against South Carolina, Warren was injected into the game and became the hero.

FSU goes into tonight's game with a 3-3 record. It has passed for 1,251 yards, has rushed for 669 yards and has returned kicks 707 yards. Tom Bailey of Miami is the team's rushing whiz and David Snell the team's dangerous kick return man.
