

tallahassee

A Salute to FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY and the city of Tallahassee

Nestled between two rivers—the Ocklockonee and the St. Marks—is the city of Tallahassee, Florida, the home of the Florida State Seminoles. Tallahassee is the state capitol of Florida and the capitol of Leon County.

The town is located twenty miles from the Gulf of Mexico and its 100,000 plus residents experience the subtropical summers of southern Florida and the foliage and color of spring and autumn.

Tallahassee has excellent recreational facilities for its residents. The town sponsors softball, football and basketball leagues for all ages. The town supports four golf courses, swimming pools and tennis courts.

For the outdoorsman, the Tallahassee area is rich in opportunities. The area around Tallahassee is known for its variety of birds for the birdwatcher. Because of the good climate and the surrounding woodlands, camping and hiking opportunities are plentiful.

The area is rich in spring-fed lakes that are well-stocked with bass, crappie and bream. For the deep-sea fisherman, the Gulf is nearby.

Tallahassee, in the middle of a heavily forested area, is a prime hunting spot. Hunters can base in Tallahassee, then go out in search of deer, turkey, quail and dove. The city is located on the waterfowl flyway, and the lakes north of town attract many geese and ducks each year.

For the spectator, Tallahassee offers a diversity of sports. The local high schools consistently produce state champions. Teams from both Florida State and Florida A & M compete with nationally-ranked schools in many sports.

Tallahassee is also the home of two of the state's finest institutions

of higher learning. Florida A & M first opened its doors in 1887 and was one of the three original institutions of public higher learning in Florida. Enrollment now tops the 5,000 student level. The "Rattlers" are known nationwide for their athletic teams.

Florida State University was begun by an 1851 legislative act which set up two seminaries in Florida. The one located in Tallahassee was designated as the "seminary West of the Suwanee" in 1857.

From 1900-1947 the school was known as the Florida State College for Women. The 1947 legislature returned the school to its co-educational status in 1947, and designated its present name.

Florida State now boasts enrollment of over 25,000 and has 10 colleges and schools with nine of them offering doctoral degrees in more than 60 fields.

Tallahassee is an Indian word

which means "oil fields" or "abandoned village". The area around Tallahassee was known to explorers long before the landing of the Mayflower. The first documented expedition crossed the area in 1528 and was followed several years later by an expedition by Hernando de Soto.

In the mid-1600's the Spaniards established Franciscan Missions throughout northern Florida and one of the more important missions gave the area its name of San Luis. In 1704 a skirmish between Col. James Moore of North Carolina and the Apalachee Indians, who were the original inhabitants of the area, forced the Indians to leave.

The United States acquired Florida from Spain in 1821 and in 1824 the young city of Tallahassee was chosen as capitol of Florida. The capitol of Florida was the only Confederate capitol east of the Mississippi River which was not threatened by Union troops during the Civil War.
