BILL DOOLEY, VIRGINIA TECH: "Our players gave a good effort and just came up on the short end of it. I congratulate the Florida State team and the FSU coaching staff."

Florida State is very explosive. They have an excellent quarterback and fine receivers. When the quarterback goes back to throw the pass, about all you can do is hold your breath and hope.

I thought we played very well in the first half. We made the big plays on defense when we had to and we got a good offensive performance. This is the first time in a good while that Kenny Lewis has been completely healthy. I think he showed what a fine running back he is.

We just weren't consistent on offense in the second half and Florida State certainly had a lot to do with that. If we could have kept something going on offense, we would have had a good chance to win the game. Our defense didn't give Florida State any easy scores until there at the end.
