AUBURN HEAD COACH PAT DYE

"I felt like we were in good shape by not being out of the ballgame at halftime. I really felt like we were ahead at the half even with giving up 13 points and turning the ball over four times.

Quarterback Reggie Slack--

(On the last drive) "We were down six and knew we had to score a touchdown to win the game. We were in our two-minute offense, taking what Florida State would give us. It came down to a couple of crucial fourth down plays and we just came up a little short on the last one."

(Slow start to open game) "We were a little sluggish offensively, especially in the first quarter. Florida State didn't really do anything we didn't expect. I threw a couple of interceptions and we left the ball on the ground, but give Florida State credit because they made some great plays. You can't leave the ball on the ground when you're playing against a team like Florida State. We beat ourselves."

Runningback Stacy Danley--

"We had too many turnovers and far too many penalties. We didn't play our kinda ball in the first half, we played Florida State's game. We regrouped after the first quarter and played our kinda game."

(On the last drive) "We were confident that we could score in the last drive. We go through that two-minute drill everyday in practice and we had done it a couple of times this season. We had the right plan, we just fell a little short at the end."

Defensive tackle Tracy Rucker--

(Florida State's quick start) "We played too cautiously at first. When you play against a wide-open offense like Florida State, you have to be prepared on every play. They don't let you relax. We thought too much at the beginning of the game. We weren't coming off the ball, we weren't doing the attacking. We did a much better job the last three quarters because we came off the ball and forced the action."

Florida State Coach Bobby Bowden following his team's  
13-7 USF&G Sugar Bowl win over Auburn:

"I'm awfully proud of this team. It's difficult to say whether this is the best team I've ever had at Florida State but at 11-1, it certainly ranks right up there.

"Our failure to score on several occasions almost cost us the game. We just flat blew four opportunities to score. Give Auburn a lot of credit, though. They just kept fighting and fighting.

"There at the end it was like the Auburn-LSU game. I was worried they were going to score and beat us by one like LSU did over Auburn.

"People usually out-tough us and we are more of a finesse team but that wasn't the case tonight. We stood right in there with them toe-to-toe. In fact, it's been a long time since we had a blood and gut football game like this one.

"On the first drive, we just came right at them. We said going into the game, 'Let's test 'em early and see what happens.' We were successful. Sammie (Smith) runs well this time of year and tonight was no exception. With his great running early we were able to establish the pace of the game.

"But after missing so many opportunities, I was real concerned. It definitely would have been my fault if we had lost the game. I should have gone for the field goal on that last drive of ours but it was on the hash mark and it would have been a tough one.

"We may be as good as any team in the country. There is no doubt Notre Dame will be number one after their win today, though. I think it will be between us and Miami for number two.

"We were pre-season number one and I think we justified those votes tonight. We were really knocked out of the title chase in our first game but we didn't fold the tents. These guys came back and I'm awfully proud of this team."

Joey Ionata, Offensive Tackle: "We had such a diversified offense. I don't think they expected us to come at them like we did. I really thought we'd score more points, but not gain as many yards as we did, tonight. Our offensive line is more than it's cracked up to be. On Sammie Smith's runs, it was a combination of great blocking and great running.

Dedrick Dodge, Free Safety: "After the Miami game, we knew we were a better team than what we showed. We matured together and peaked right after mid season and played well the last four-5 games of the year.

They were ~~coming~~ coming up with some big plays. They made several 4th down conversions b-cause we were concentrating on not giving up the big play. We felt all along like we could stop ty-em if we just didn't gibe up a long gainer. They got a couple breaks and we got a couple breaks just when they thought Prime Time was gone, he makes ~~XXXXX~~ the key play of the game. I think in the end the best team won.

Sammie Smith, Tailback: I knew they would be tough to run against. I prepared myself all week long to get mentally ready to run as hard as I could. They were by far the toughest team we played all year. Their linemen (def. front) is just awesone. I kinda got tired quick in the beginning after recovering from the flu . I tried to drink fluids all week to protect myself, and I actually felt better as the game got to the end. I want to take a couple of days and talk to my parents, then come back and talk to Coach Bowden before I make a decision (on turning pro). Whether I had 30 yards in this game or as many as I did will not make any difference in my decision.

Deion Sanders,,Cornerback: The ending to the game was a story book ending. All week in my mind I visualized what would happen in this game and how it would end. On the last play, we had man to man coverage, I was trailing the receiver by 2-3 yards and in the end I was able to come up with the big play. But I've got to admist that by the end of the game I was ytired, but not quarterback can pick ~~pon~~ me. I was very frustrated during the game because I didn't get a chance to return any punts. Auburn was a very physical team, but FSU, not known for its defense, came thru in the end. Auburn tricked us on the first TD, they lulled us to sleep during the drive and the touchdown was my fault. The Auburn players offended us by saying that we could not play for Pat Dye. They said that Coach Bowden had no control over out team.

Odell Haggins, Noseguard: It was a great effort by Florida State. When people 2 talk about FSU, they always talk about the offense and tend to ditch the defense. We proved tonight that we have the best defense in the nation. People played up the South Carolina, Florida and Auburn defense and we showed them all up. When we gave the offense the ball four times in the first quarter and only came away with 13 points, I knew it would be a defensive game.
