### SERIES INFORMATION

In the past two seasons, in-state rival Miami is the only school in the nation with a better record than Florida State's 22-2... during that time, UM is 23-1... Miami, FSU's oldest rival, as the schools have faced off 32 times since 1951... the Hurricanes are on a four-game winning streak in the series and hold a 19-13 lead overall... coincidentally, the last four games have all been televised nationally... last time the two teams met in Tallahassee, they played a classic... Miami staged a furious comeback to take a 26-25 win and it was the second time in the decade the Canes destroyed FSU national title hopes... In 1980, UM beat FSU 10-9 for the lone blemish on the Seminoles' record that season... surprisingly, the tribe has won only one game of ten in Tallahassee in this series, that a 40-23 victory in 1978... Dennis Erikson is one of three first-year head coaches Florida State will face this year... last year, Miami broke FSU's string of 11 straight season opening wins and became the first team in 12 years to shut out the Seminoles... ironically, the Hurricanes also accomplished the feat in 1976.

Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden

"This feels so good. It's the way it should have been the last four years I guess. You got to give credit to our goal line defense. I guess they got it down there at least three times and didn't get it in. Our passing game just couldn't get off the ground. We didn't have time to throw all night. Their defense is just so good, we could hardly get anything done. Thank goodness our running game worked. You got to thank the offensive line and the running backs for that. I'm telling you, we had receivers running open all night, but we just couldn't get the ball off. The pressure was too great. Just credit the defense and the running game. We put pressure on their passer all night. I think that may have led to some of the interceptions. We couldn't ever get to him, but believe me, he was throwing off his back foot a lot. This is just a great win. I guess it's so great, because we hadn't beaten them in four years."

### MIAMI QUOTES

Head Coach Dennis Erickson: The story of the game was basically that they outplayed us. You can't turn the ball over as many times as we did and expect to beat an outstanding team like Florida State. Offensively we were sporadic, but give them credit. They made the plays and did what they had to do to win the game. If we scored those two times we were on their one yard line, it would have been a different game. But we didn't and they flat beat us. We have four more games to play and we will perform well, because this team has an awful lot of character.

GINO TORRETTA : I made some bad throws, and some of the guys didn't get open, but I'll take most of the blame for the loss. Four interceptions is frustrating. You can't win ball games when you turn it over down close. Give them credit, they played well.

Bernard Clark: Like I said before the game, the team that made the most mistakes would lose, and we just made too many. We had a lot of mental breakdowns both offensively and defensively. We had just too many to win the football game. We're still in it (the national championship picture). If we win the last four, we can get back into it. We just got to work harder.
